ABATE of Indiana's DIRT BIKE SCHOOL

Prerequisites for class: Ability to ride a bicycle.

Required riding gear: Helmet, full-finger gloves, sturdy over the ankle boots, long pants without holes, long sleeve shirt or jacket and eye protection.

Bikes and helmets: Some loaner bikes and helmets may be available at no additional cost. If available, you are encouraged to bring your own bike and helmet to ensure proper size and fit.

Cost: \$75 ages 6-15*
\$100 ages 16 and up
\$300 family of 4 (\$60 per each additional student)
Groups or families of four or more, please call to schedule a date.

Age restrictions: *6-11 year olds can only enroll in class with other 6-11 year olds, unless enrolled in a family class. Maximum number of 6-11 year olds in a class is 4.
