GUIDELINES

Eligibility: Any person with a “tour passport” who can show proof of motorcycle license endorsement by sending a photocopy of their license with completed passport (passenger not required to have endorsement). Only one passport per person accepted.

Couples: Couples (riding on the same motorcycle) must use separate “tour passports” to be eligible for prizes.

Completion Date: December 31, 2025 all “tour passports” and/or pictures must be post-marked by January 15, 2026.

Categories: There will be five categories for the tour; North, Central and South Point of Interest Tours, the ABCs of Indiana Tour, and the Sponsor Tour.

Tour Patches: Tour patches will be awarded to first time participants and rockers for those who previously participated.

AWARD PACKAGE

- 1 A drawing will be held no later than the ABATE Awards Ceremony in 2026.
- 2 A total of \$1,500 cash prizes will be given away.
- 3 The TOTAL cash prize will be divided equally between the tours. \$900 will be divided between the North, Central and South Points of Interest Tours. \$300 will be awarded to the ABCs of Indiana Tour. \$300 will be awarded to the Sponsor Tour.
- 4 There are a maximum of 120 chances per passport that can be accumulated from the Tour for the drawing of the cash prizes. Participants are eligible to win all cash prizes.
- 5 Anyone accumulating all 120 chances will automatically receive a one-year ABATE of Indiana membership.
- 6 Anyone completing one Points-of-Interest Tour and the ABCs of Indiana Tour will qualify for one chance at an all-events pass for 2026. Additional chances can be earned by adding a picture of the ABATE of Indiana state office, the Indiana State Motorcycle Safety Memorial and/or Coliseum Bingo (Freedom Hall). A total of four chances can be earned for an all-events pass. There will be 14 passes given away.
- 7 If less than three participants complete either category of the tour, the money will be divided equally among those who have participated in any of the tours.



HOW THE TOUR WORKS

Think of ABATE of Indiana's "Tour Indiana" program as a statewide scavenger hunt designed to encourage people to get out and ride. If that wasn't incentive enough, you can also win cash prizes! How, you ask?

Points of Interest (POI) Participants may visit the points of interest listed in this passport. Participants may ride the North Tour (Regions 0, 1, 2, 3, 4), Central Tour (Regions 5, 6, 11, 12) or South Tour (Regions 7, 8, 9, 10, 13) separately, any combination of two, or all three. A point of interest is listed in each Region (two in Region 11). There are five points of interest in each of the North, Central and South Tours (15 total). Participants simply take a picture of their motorcycle and themselves in front of the point of interest, while displaying the cover of the tour book. Couples (riding the same motorcycle) can take a picture of each other with their motorcycle, while displaying the cover page of the tour book. Participants will qualify for 2 chances per picture to win cash prizes for each of these tours they complete.

ABCs of Indiana Participants must take a picture of their motorcycle and themselves in front of the name of a city, town or county sign using the alphabet A through Z (there is no X), while displaying the cover of the tour book. Couples (riding the same motorcycle) can take a picture of each other with their motorcycle, while displaying the cover of the tour book. A picture of five of the State Parks and/or State/National Forests is also needed. Participants will receive two chances for each letter of the alphabet, State/National Park or State/National Forest submitted. There are a total of 60 chances available for this tour.

Sponsor Tour Visit a sponsor listed on the inside back cover. Participants must take a picture of their motorcycle and themselves in front of the business signage while displaying the cover of the tour book (15 total). Participants will qualify for 2 chances per picture to win cash prizes for this tour. Only one sponsor can be submitted under the same name (i.e. "Coliseum Bingo" can only be submitted one time, even though they are listed multiple times). There are currently 41 Sponsors available to choose from for this tour. BONUS, all meeting locations listed at the beginning of each region's news section in "Hoosier Motorcyclist" magazine count as additional locations.



Charles C. Deam Historical Marker at Pickett's Run Park

Appointed Indiana's first State Forester (1909-1913, 1917-1928), Charles C. Deam was also a druggist and avid collector of botanical specimens throughout the state from the 1890s - 1920s. He documented important biological transitions taking place between the eras of virgin forests and intensive agricultural cultivation. The marker is located at the intersection of E. Market St and Wayne St. Not a lot of room on the road but if the ground is dry, you should be able to get out of traffic to get your picture. But be warned, Pickett's Run is not just a park but actually a former tributary to the Wabash River located just across Market Steet.

Golden Dome - Notre Dame

The Golden Dome is the focal point of the Notre Dame campus and sits atop the Main Building in the center of everything. Fire destroyed the Main Building in April of 1879, and the current building was begun in June. By the fall semester of 1879, the new building was completed. With a shortage of skilled workers due to the Great 1871 Chicago fire, women comprised the force of workers accomplishing this feat. The dome was added to the building in 1883 and has undergone regilding 11 times since, most recently in 2023. There are a number of locations you can stop to get your picture just be conscientious of where you are.




Old Ben & Sycamore Stump

Located inside Highland Park in Kokomo, this POI is a true twofer. Your picture will be of the shelter, but the real gem of the stop is what it houses. Two historic items: first is the statue of Old Ben, a record-setting steer born in 1902, and he grew to over 4,500 pounds, standing over six feet high, 14 feet round, and over 16 feet from nose to tail. The second part of the stop in the same shelter is the Sycamore stump. Now, this is no ordinary hunk of wood. The tree once stood in the western part of Howard County. Rumored to be 100 feet tall before storms took it down in 1916. The stump is almost 8 feet across and is estimated to be 1,500 years old. The park is located south of downtown along Kokomo Creek. Access is only from the east; follow Defenbaugh St to the intersection with Park St. Continue ahead, then bear right; the shelter will be on your left.




There is a nice parking area you can pull into for your picture and take a minute to stretch and walk around the store.



Battle of Corydon Historic Site

This POI is the site of the only pitched battle of the Civil War fought in Indiana. The Battle of Corydon was a minor engagement that took place July 9, 1863, just south of Corydon, between Indiana Legion forces (mostly local landowners) and Confederate forces led by Brig. Gen. John H Morgan. Morgan's Raiders, as they were known, were looking for supplies and sympathizers in support of the Southern Cause. They did not find what they expected and met with stiff resistance that was overcome only by sheer numbers and a good bluff with two canon shots into the middle of Corydon. Although the short battle cost the Confederate cavalry twice as many casualties as the outnumbered Indiana militia units, the battle resulted in a Confederate victory, which enabled Gen. Morgan to secure supplies and money before continuing his raids through Indiana and into Ohio. The delay, however, proved critical in helping the pursuing Union army overtake and later capture Morgan and his forces



The Old Perry County Courthouse, also known as the Rome Schoolhouse, is a historic courthouse located in Tobin Township, Perry County, Indiana. The building is located near the center of the unincorporated community of Rome, Indiana. It was built in 1818 and is a two-story, square brick building with a hipped roof topped by a central cupola. The building served as the seat of county government until 1859. It then housed a school until 1966. The stop should look familiar as the building bears a striking resemblance to the Corydon State Capitol building we had in 2023 and was a stop on the tour about thirteen years ago.





Billie Creek Covered Bridge

The Billie Creek Covered Bridge is a Burr Arch structure that was built by Joseph J. Daniels in 1895. This bridge was built to replace the open wooden bridge that had been built by famed bridge builder J.A. Britton just 15 years earlier, in 1880. It was built on what was then called the Pikes Peak Ocean to Ocean Highway, which would later become U.S. 36. The bridge was saved because it was later bypassed when the road was rebuilt. Billie Creek covered bridge was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1978. It is typically open to vehicles except at busy times of the year, like Civil War Day at Billie Creek Village and the Parke County Bridge Festival.



Burr Oak School Marker

This POI was submitted by Christian Harper; however, he found very little information for the marker. The location of the Burr Oak School was originally part of Knox County. It was first transferred to Gibson County in 1810 but was then made a part of Pike County in 1824 when Indiana reorganized many of the county boundaries. The school was in operation when the Public School Laws were enacted in 1852. The marker is located on the west side of the intersection of 1000 E & 475 N, about 2.5 miles north of Otwell. If you take Spring St north out of Otwell, it will be on your left in the curve to 475 N. Interesting note: the town of Otwell is one of only two such named towns in the country. The other is in Arkansas.


