Learn to ride from the people who have been conducting courses for over 40 years and trained more than 140,000 riders.

Our Basic Riding Skills (BRS) course is intended to help individuals acquire the basic knowledge and skills needed for safe and responsible motorcycle operation. Upon successful completion of the class, students can get their motorcycle endorsement from the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles.

The course will help students: Learn the mental skills for safe motorcycling, understand the risks associated with motorcycling, identify and develop strategies to manage that risk, and understand how their decisions affect their ability to ride safely. They will also gain the physical skills for safe motorcycling by developing the basic skills needed to ride in a straight line, shift, turn, and stop the motorcycle. Improve cornering and braking techniques as students practice braking and swerving skills needed for emergencies.

Our goal is to help students be successful and safe. We encourage students to ask questions. Our instructors help them discover the answers, as they concentrate on developing their skills and strategies -- the first steps to riding safely!

ABATE of Indiana's dirt bike school is designed for motorcycle riders ages 6 and up who wish to learn the basics of off-road riding. This one-day, hands-on class is a fun way to get your entire family ready for fun on the trails in a safe and responsible manner.

The Dirt Bike School curriculum was developed by the Motorcycle Safety Foundation and has been used to prepare peace officers and military personnel in the safe operation of off-road motorcycles for years.

Riders spend the entire time performing hands-on training on the motorcycles at the end of the class, students should have an understanding of the techniques necessary to stay safe, act responsibly and have fun while riding off-road motorcycles.

Since children as young as six years of age can enroll, the Dirt Bike School provides an opportunity for the entire family to participate in this exciting learning experience.

Most students prefer to use their own equipment, however loaner motorcycles and gear may be available.
