GUIDELINES

Eligibility: Any person with a “tour passport” who can show proof of motorcycle license endorsement by sending a photocopy of their license with completed passport (passenger not required to have endorsement). Only one passport per person accepted.

Couples: Couples (riding on the same motorcycle) must use separate “tour passports” to be eligible for prizes.

Completion Date: December 31, 2026 all “tour passports” and/or pictures must be post-marked by January 15, 2027.

Categories: There will be five categories for the tour; North, Central and South Point of Interest Tours, the ABCs of Indiana Tour, and the Sponsor Tour.

Tour Patches: Tour patches will be awarded to first time participants and rockers for those who previously participated.

AWARD PACKAGE

- 1 A drawing will be held no later than the ABATE Awards Ceremony in 2027.
- 2 A total of \$1,500 cash prizes will be given away.
- 3 The TOTAL cash prize will be divided equally between the tours. \$900 will be divided between the North, Central and South Points of Interest Tours. \$300 will be awarded to the ABCs of Indiana Tour. \$300 will be awarded to the Sponsor Tour.
- 4 There are a maximum of 120 chances per passport that can be accumulated from the Tour for the drawing of the cash prizes. Participants are eligible to win all cash prizes.
- 5 Anyone accumulating all 120 chances will automatically receive a one-year ABATE of Indiana membership.
- 6 Anyone completing one Points-of-Interest Tour and the ABCs of Indiana Tour will qualify for one chance at an all-events pass for 2027. Additional chances can be earned by adding a picture of the Indiana State Motorcycle Safety Memorial, and/or Coliseum Bingo (ABATE of Indiana office). A total of four chances can be earned for an all-events pass. There will be 14 passes given away.
- 7 If less than three participants complete either category of the tour, the money will be divided equally among those who have participated in any of the tours.



HOW THE TOUR WORKS

Think of ABATE of Indiana's "Tour Indiana" program as a statewide scavenger hunt designed to encourage people to get out and ride. If that wasn't incentive enough, you can also win cash prizes! How, you ask?

Points of Interest (POI) Participants may visit the points of interest listed in this passport. Participants may ride the North Tour (Regions 0, 1, 2, 3, 4), Central Tour (Regions 5, 6, 11, 12) or South Tour (Regions 7, 8, 9, 10, 13) separately, any combination of two, or all three. A point of interest is listed in each Region (two in Region 11). There are five points of interest in each of the North, Central and South Tours (15 total). Participants simply take a picture of their motorcycle and themselves in front of the point of interest, while displaying the cover of the tour book. Couples (riding the same motorcycle) can take a picture of each other with their motorcycle, while displaying the cover page of the tour book. Participants will qualify for 2 chances per picture to win cash prizes for each of these tours they complete.

ABCs of Indiana Participants must take a picture of their motorcycle and themselves in front of the name of a city, town or county sign using the alphabet A through Z (there is no X), while displaying the cover of the tour book. Couples (riding the same motorcycle) can take a picture of each other with their motorcycle, while displaying the cover of the tour book. A picture of five of the State Parks and/or State/National Forests is also needed. Participants will receive two chances for each letter of the alphabet, State/National Park or State/National Forest submitted. There are a total of 60 chances available for this tour.

Sponsor Tour Visit a sponsor listed on the inside back cover. Participants must take a picture of their motorcycle and themselves in front of the business signage while displaying the cover of the tour book (15 total). Participants will qualify for 2 chances per picture to win cash prizes for this tour. Only one sponsor can be submitted under the same name (i.e. "Coliseum Bingo" can only be submitted one time, even though they are listed multiple times). There are currently 41 Sponsors available to choose from for this tour. BONUS, all meeting locations listed at the beginning of each region's news section in "Hoosier Motorcyclist" magazine count as additional locations.

Bonus Complete all 5 Tours (3 Point of Interest Tours, ABC Tour, and Sponsor Tour) and receive an additional 15 chances to be evenly distributed among the five tours!



In this year of celebrating the Semiquincentennial of our country, I begin the Tour Indiana Program with a historic marker commemorating the Revolutionary War. Colonel Augustine De La Balme came to America to help the American cause and, according to the marker, had secret orders from George Washington to raid the British stores in Kekionga, present-day Ft Wayne. He raided the British outposts in Fort Wayne and Detroit. His success was short-lived, as he lost the small contingent left in Fort Wayne to the Miami Indians, and he did not receive the anticipated support from the residents around Detroit.

The Studebaker National Museum is devoted to sharing the story of the automotive and industrial history of South Bend and the greater region through the display and interpretation of Studebaker vehicles along with related industrial artifacts. The Collection also includes seven objects designated as “National Treasures,” including the carriage Abraham Lincoln rode to Ford’s Theatre the night of his assassination, and a carriage used by the Marquis de Lafayette during his farewell tour of the United States in 1824. Now through May, the museum has cars from TV and films, like the 1966 Ford Thunderbird from Thelma & Louise and the 1982 Ferrari 308 GTSi from Magnum PI.



We probably all know a little about Orville Redenbacher, but did you know he was from Indiana? He was actually born in Brazil, Indiana, but after college, he and his partner, Charles F Bowman, purchased the George F Chester seed corn plant in Boone Grove in 1951. This company became a worldwide supplier of popcorn seed while also selling to customers at its plant in Valparaiso. In 1970, the company launched its Orville Redenbacher's Gourmet Popping Corn with the tagline "World's most expensive popping corn". We just don't get truth in advertising like that anymore. The POI is on the north side of Central Park Plaza at the corner of Lafayette St. and Lincoln Way.

The home includes a Victorian-era flower garden, vegetable and medicinal herb gardens, and the stone barn where Dr. Ford's faithful steed, Barney, is located.



Dan Patch Historic Marker

The marker is located on the right side of Michigan St, just north of Benton St in Oxford. Dan Patch was a noted American Standardbred pacer. At a time when harness racing was one of the largest sports in the nation, Dan Patch was a major celebrity. He was undefeated in open competition and was so dominant on the racetrack that other owners eventually refused to enter their horses against him. He died on July 11, 1916, and the headstone to the right of the marker is just a memorial; his final resting place is rumored to be on the stable property in Minnesota in an unmarked grave.

The mural, painted in 2017 on the Community Center's south wall by Holly Cooper, was assisted by a number of local volunteers with the prep work. The train depicts a steam engine photographed on the tracks in Roachdale in 1941. The Monon Railroad passed through Roachdale, and in 1880, the B&O Railroad came through, and they crossed in this small Indiana town. The population boomed from just three families to 350 people in 1885 and to over 900 by 1900, with over 90 businesses supporting the economy. The railroad clearly boosted this community.

The Frank Wheeler Hotel, also known as the Brown-Wheeler House, is a historic hotel building in Freetown, Indiana, listed on the National Register of Historic Places. It was built in 1890 and is a modest two-story, Queen Anne-style frame building. The building features asymmetrical massing, multiple gables, and a large porch with turned and decorative woodwork. Also on the property are the contributing shed and privy. Built as a private dwelling, it housed a hotel from 1905 to 1938.

Bob Griese was born in Evansville in 1945 and played all sports in high school and college. He developed his football skills

at Purdue, and this served him well in his pro career. Widely regarded as one of the greatest quarterbacks of the 1970s, Griese led the Dolphins to, at the time, record three consecutive Super Bowl appearances, including two Super Bowl victories in VII and VIII, the first of which capped off Miami's undefeated and untied 1972 season, the only such season in NFL history. He was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame and the Indiana Football Hall of Fame in 1984 and the Pro Football Hall of Fame in 1990.







The sculpture is located in the middle of the round-about at Arlington Ave and Churchman Bypass. This sculpture, produced by Bo Mar Industries, stands over 21 feet tall and weighs 3,500 pounds. The city raised \$55,000 for the project, which features the mascot of the local high school, and it was completed in the summer of 2020. There are parking lots to the northeast and southwest of the sculpture, and the address is the location of the Bo Mar offices.

You can see it, but the effect is not the same. The ribbon cutting was just last November, so the newness has not yet worn off. People who visit the center can see a real Indy car housed inside, along with plaques, racing helmets, and memorabilia showcasing the illustrious history of the Indianapolis Motor Speedway.


